Newborn Critical Care Center (NCCC) Clinical Guidelines

6 Women's NICU - EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN

Context: Beginning on June 29, 2021 the Newborn Critical Care Center (NCCC) will house eight neonatal intensive care patients on the 6th floor Women's Hospital beds: 6W15-6W22. These patients will be staffed with an NCCC nurse, NNP and Neonatal Attending providers. In the event of an emergency the code team from the NCCC will respond and will be contacted as outlined in the process below.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACTIVATION:

- 1. Emergency identified and 6 Women's HUC/CST will be instructed to call a neonatal code to a certain 6W bed number.
- 2. 6 Women's HUC/CST will contact:
 - NCCC (4-3481) and NCCC HUC will overhead "Code 6 Women's BED number"
 - b. NCCC charge nurse (4-6493)
 - c. NCCC Emergency Access Line (4-6281)
 - d. No information will be provided by the 6W HUC/CST except "Code" and the "Bed number."
- 3. The NCCC code team will respond in full
