Gather equipment (suture removal kit, antiseptic solution, tegaderm, steri-strips, sterile gloves) and clean surface of tray/cart.							
Verify patient identification per hospital policy. Wash hands.*							
Put on hat and mask.*							
Place equipment on sterile field.							
Prepare dressing for removal by cleaning outside of dressing with Chloraprep.							
Repeat hand hygiene and double glove.*							
Gently remove external steri-strips. Loosen dressing by stretching edges of tegaderm for easy removal.							
Gently remove old dressing and steri-strips underneath. Remove outer gloves.*							
Cleanse the site with betadine/Chloraprep. Allow to dry 1-2 minutes.*							
Place two steri-strips over hub and cover with transparent dressing.							
Secure catheter with chevron and steri-strips. (Optional: use securement device if available.)							
Hand hygiene after completion.*							
Dressing documentation in EMR: Document PICC dressing change, length of catheter external to skin, and patient's response to procedure.
